A town for the people who live here all year round.

These are uncertain times. On a global level, the pandemic and the conflict in Ukraine have shown us to be more vulnerable than we thought. In Soller we have important challenges to face, which cannot be ignored as has happened in the current legislature.

We are feminists, we want life in the centre. We are feminists, we want life at the centre. That is why it is urgent to find a balance between economic activity linked to tourism and the well-being of the people who live in Sóller all year round; to stop gentrification in order to gain access to affordable housing.

We must work to preserve our essence, those things that make us who we are. Our culture, our language, our rural community, and our heritage are a wealth that we must protect and grow in order to protect our identity as a community.

A community that looks to the future, willing to take on the challenge of sustainability with courage. We want houses with solar panels; we want accessible urban spaces, with trees and well-tended gardens; we want worthy and inclusive schools and playgrounds; we want to finish the Defensora and build a day centre.

We want a town for the future, worthy of the people of Soller. With your vote we will make it possible!

We want to live in Soller

1. We will carry out a comprehensive study of the permanently blocked housing, it's habitability, the level of occupation and its destination.
2. We will involve the Balearic Government in the building of social housing.
3. We will facilitate the horizontal division of old houses so that those who inherit a house are not forced to sell.
4. We will apply a moratorium on the licensing of inland hotels.

5. We will annually control the true population of the municipality: residents, hotel beds, and tourist rental places.
6. We will adopt fiscal measures to tax housing speculation.

Our productive and commercial fabric, in local terms

1. We will enhance the value of our network of local commerce with specific fiscal policies and coordination actions with all the traders of Soller and the Port and the different associations that represent them.
2. Through specific fiscal policies, the coordination with local traders in Soller and in the Port as well as with the different associations that represent them, we will enhance the value of our network of local commerce.
3. We will promote the municipal market as a dynamic centre for the promotion of local products and we will resolve the renewal of concessions. We will promote measures such as free parking with purchase tickets, a children's play area and fairs and promotions.
4. We will create a distinctive seal for companies that produce local products. We will encourage good practices in terms of waste generation with discounts on the commercial waste tax.
5. We will create a land bank to facilitate the meeting between landowners who cannot grow on their land and volunteers who wish to care for it.
6. We will give new impetus to the "Sóller Bon dia" cluster. We will strengthen the role of the Employment and local development officer (AODL) in providing support in terms of subsidies and the creation of companies and cooperatives.
7. We will request the incorporation of new training courses at the IES Guillem Colom, so that our young people have a wide range of opportunities to decide on their professional training.

A feminist community

1. We will promote the participation and visibility of women in the institutional, political, cultural, sporting and social spheres.

2. We will push for a local pact for equality, a body for consultation and participation of citizens in matters of equality between men and women.
3. We will recover the historical memory of women and revise the nomenclature of Sóller's streets in terms of gender.
4. We will promote the use of non-sexist language in all actions promoted by the Town Council.
5. We will work for the prevention and elimination of gender violence.
6. We will facilitate the creation and deployment of coeducational programmes in schools.

Culture, sports and health

1. We will finish the work on the Defensora Theatre and draw up a plan for the medium-term use of all municipal cultural spaces.
2. We will protect and disseminate the historical and cultural heritage and promote a broad, diverse, cross-cultural and quality programme as a means of social integration and personal enrichment for people of all ages.
3. We will give priority to inclusive and environmentally friendly sports and we will promote school sports, municipal sports camps, healthy sports activities for the elderly and women's sports.
4. We will efficiently maintain our sports facilities, always ensuring their multi-purpose use and sustainability.
5. We will recover the Municipal Culture Council and the Municipal Sports Council and we will care for the groups, entities and people who dedicate their time to making and disseminating culture and sport in our city.
6. We will work for mental health, for the prevention of addictions and to promote healthy lifestyles.

Citizen support and services.

1. We will make the refurbishment of the old Escorxador a reality and the Fontanelles Day Centre will become operational. We will promote policies for the inclusion of groups at risk of social exclusion and we will approve collaboration agreements to consolidate collaboration with social entities

2. We will negotiate the improvement of our Health Centre so that it has more staff, an X-ray service, a rehabilitation service and more paediatric hours. We will also attend to the spatial needs of third sector organisations and associations that do not have premises.
3. We will reactivate the Regulation on Transparency and Citizen Participation and promote its implementation. We will eliminate the need to make prior appointments with the Town Council.
4. The Municipal School Council will be a true space for the coordination of the educational community and we will promote inclusive extracurricular activities and summer schools.
5. We will demand the immediate fulfilment of the Agreement with the Conselleria for Education, for the improvement of Sóller's public schools and we will consolidate a new school brigade for the daily maintenance of the schools.
6. We will create an adult learning centre, we will continue to demand a branch of the Official Language School in Sóller and we will unify the whole range of leisure activities and workshops in a single agenda.

The town, spaces and mobility

1. We will draw up an accessibility plan for our streets, buildings and other public spaces. We will modify the ordinance on the occupation of public roads so that it is especially respectful of the public use of municipal spaces, and we will enforce it.
2. We will consolidate the Open Schoolyards project, we will improve and include children's playgrounds and we will begin a reform of the public schoolyards so that they are shaded and friendlier.
3. We will promote safe school routes with the aim of facilitating accessibility and safety for pupils, on foot or by bicycle.
4. We will seek the reception of private housing developments in the Port of Sóller, supporting their adaptation by means of special contributions.
5. We will promote the update of the Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan to review and improve car parking areas, cycle lanes, bicycle and skateboard parking areas, the creation of a bus that connects the different urban centres and the identification of healthy routes.

6. We will take care of public green spaces; we will increase the network of public, adapted and accessible toilets and we will plan the progressive burying of electric cables. We will defend the catalogue of public paths in Sóller and we will carry out adequate maintenance and signposting.

A town with a future

1. We will defend the installation of solar panels over and above landscape criteria, we will solarise municipal buildings and plots and we will explore other renewable energies.
2. We will define a sustainable waste management model and we will quickly resolve the new selective waste collection concession, guaranteeing the improvement of the service and the efficient management of waste. We will put more litter bins in the streets.
3. We will plan a municipal plant for the treatment of the organic waste, which will allow the use of the milled waste, the management of pruning waste and the generation of compost.
4. We will adopt measures to reduce the salinity levels of wastewater, we will continue with the tertiary treatment plant project initiated by the Regional Ministry of Agriculture and we will implement the use of reclaimed water for recycling.
5. We will encourage initiatives to promote and reinforce the identity of the valley's agricultural products and create mechanisms to facilitate the agricultural management of horticulture and olive groves, which is essential to maintain a territory based on primary sector activity
6. We will promote the protection and conservation of vulnerable ecosystems, among them s'Illeta and the Soller bay. We will draw up a management plan to ensure the good health and correct maintenance of urban stretches of streams and public lighting, while guaranteeing transparency and raising awareness.

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
